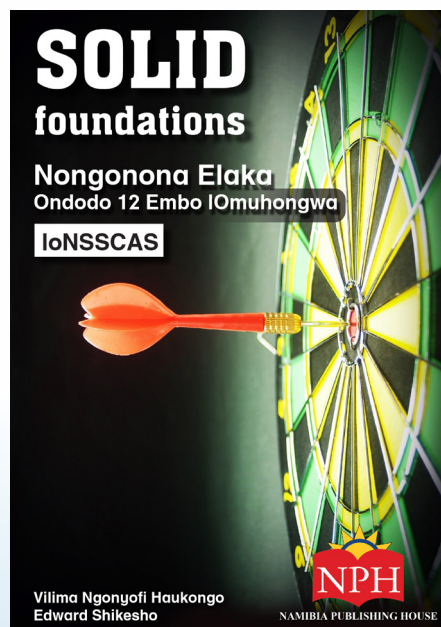


Introducing latest additions to the Solid Foundations series of textbooks for African Languages for NSSCAS:
